

Probable Maximum Loss (PML) RFP Requirements

For XYZ Data Centre we require the successful bidder to provide us with a PML study and report which would include, as a minimum, the under mentioned factors:

- Review of any available geological information for the land and the surrounding areas.
- Review of the site soil boring data when the building was first constructed.
- Review of the Structural and Architectural design of the DC.
- Review of the structural characteristics of the DC.
- Review of any seismic force resisting systems that were installed originally or retro-fitted.
- Review of any vulnerabilities that may have been identified.
- Review of soil amplification for the site/building.
- Perform a probabilistic seismic risk analysis for the location.
- Calculation of expected annual loss and/or damage.
- Potential Business Interruption as an order of magnitude estimate.

RFP Submission and additional information

- The submitted PML report must be in English and the cost of translation, if any, is deemed to be included in the quoted fees.
- Any travel or other incidental expenses are also deemed to be included in the quoted fees.
- Your report must be in hard copy with a PDF copy recorded on to a CD.
- The Owner shall retain the right to distribute the PML, without modification, to our existing and potential clients without the payment of any additional fees
